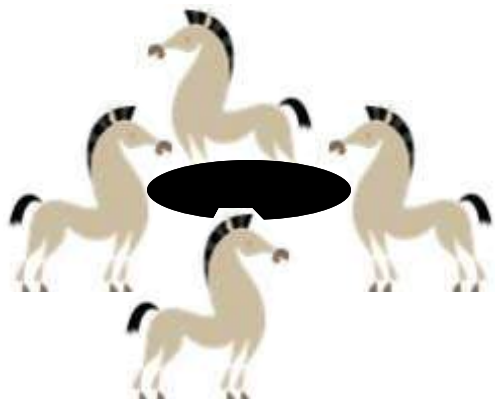
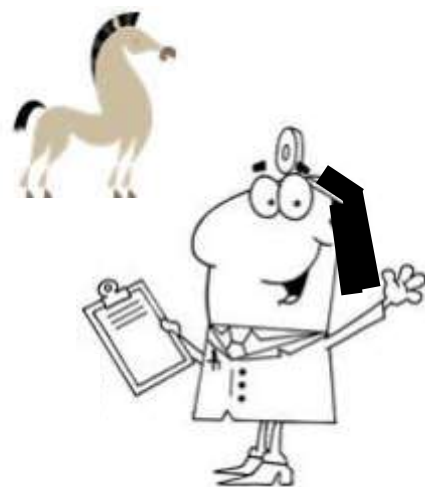


ANNOUNCING VADA/Nova's WINTER UNMOUNTED CLINICS

Thursday Feb 23rd at 7pm - **"Ask the Vet"**

This is an informal evening of Q & As with Dr. Mia Lee. You have seen Dr. Lee at the VADA/Nova shows, where she serves as our show vet - now is your chance to sit down with her and have her answer all your burning horse health questions. Dr Lee will start the session with tips **to help you get your horse ready for spring and then we'll open the floor to questions from the audience.** Dr. Lee grew up in the Northern Virginia area and was an avid equestrian. She is a graduate of the Virginia Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine, completed a 1-year internship at the Marion DuPont Equine Medical Center and in 2007 she opened Solstice Equine Veterinary Services, an ambulatory only practice dedicated to providing high quality care and medicine to patients on a more individualized basis.
